
Restoration of the Historic Streetcar in Downtown Los Angeles Finding of No Significant Impact (FONSI) Available for Review

The Federal Transit Administration (FTA) in coordination with the City of Los Angeles (the City) is proposing to restore the historic streetcar service in downtown Los Angeles (Project). An Environmental Assessment (EA) was prepared and circulated to the public for review and comment from July 23, 2018 until August 21, 2018. After reviewing the EA and supporting documents, including public comments and responses made thereto, the FTA finds under 23 Code of Federal Regulations 771.121 that the Project with committed mitigation will have no significant adverse impact on the environment. The record provides sufficient evidence and analysis for determining that an Environmental Impact Statement is not required. FTA also finds, in accordance with Federal Transit Law 49 United States Code 5324(6), that an adequate opportunity to present views was given to all parties with significant economic, social, cultural, or environmental interest, that the preservation and enhancement of the environment and the interest of the community in which the Project is located were considered.
