

Project Title: Sibannac, LLC Pond-Spillway and Stream Crossing Maintenance (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2017-0080-R1)

Project Location (include county): The project site is located at 1500 Hyampom Road, approximately 1.5 miles west of the town of Hayfork in Trinity County, California within the Hayfork Creek watershed. The stream crossing and spillway maintenance projects are located an unnamed ephemeral stream and an unnamed perennial tributary to Hayfork Creek; Section 10, Township 31N, Range 12W; U.S. Geological Survey Hayfork 7.5 Minute Quad Map. Mt. Diablo Meridian.

Project Description: The projects as covered under the scope of the Streambed Alteration Agreement are limited to the upgrading of two existing ford crossings to meet 100-year flow criteria as well as maintenance and in-stream stabilization activities associated with the spillway and downstream section of existing reservoir in order to minimize sedimentation in the watershed.
