SUBJECT: Filing of Notice of Determination pursuant to Public Resources Code section 21108

Project Title: Wahlberg Water Diversion and Stream Crossings Project (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2018-0081-R1)

Project Location: The project to be completed is located within the Navarro River watershed, approximately 3.6 miles west of the town of Boonville, County of Mendocino, State of California. The project is located in Section 7, T 13N, R 14W, Mt. Diablo Base and Meridian; in the Philo U.S. Geological Survey 7.5-minute quadrangle; Assessor's Parcel Nos: 029-660-31, latitude/longitude: 39.0053, -123.4398 at the point of diversion (POD).

Project Description: The project is limited to seven (7) encroachments (Table 1). Two (2) encroachments are for water diversion from springs that are unnamed tributaries to Rancheria Creek. Water is diverted for domestic use and irrigation. Work for the water diversion will include use and maintenance of the water diversion infrastructure. The five (5) other proposed encroachments are to upgrade failing and undersized culverts and replenish rock in failed rocked fords. Work for these encroachments will include excavation, removal of the failing culverts, replacement with new properly sized culverts, backfilling and compaction of fill, and rock armoring as necessary to minimize erosion.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as the Lead Agency / a Responsible Agency approved the above described project and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. A mitigated negative declaration / negative declaration was prepared for this project pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.
CDFW considered the mitigated negative declaration / negative declaration prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures were / were not made a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.
4. A mitigation reporting or monitoring plan was / was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
5. A Statement of Overriding Considerations was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
6. Findings were not made by CDFW pursuant to Public Resources Code section 21081, subdivision (a).
