Pursuant to Senate Bill 18 (Government Code § 65352.3) and in an effort to fully evaluate potential adverse effects to cultural resources, the City of Fairfield is contacting you to provide notice of the following project. The Native American Heritage Commission (NAHC) provided us with a Native American Tribal Consultation List (December 14, 2017) applicable to the project. You were among those listed by NAHC.

Project Name: Green Valley II Mixed-Use

Project Location: The project is located at the southwest corner of Business Center Drive and Suisun Valley Road within the City of Fairfield, Solano County, CA (APNs: 148-540-270 and 148-540-300). The infill parcel is located in a developed urban area of Fairfield. Specifically, the site is bound by Business Center Drive to the north and west, Suisun Valley and Neitzel Roads to the east, and an undeveloped parcel to the south. The majority of the site is an open field that consists of natural grass vegetation and a single oak tree. The site has been routinely mowed and disked.

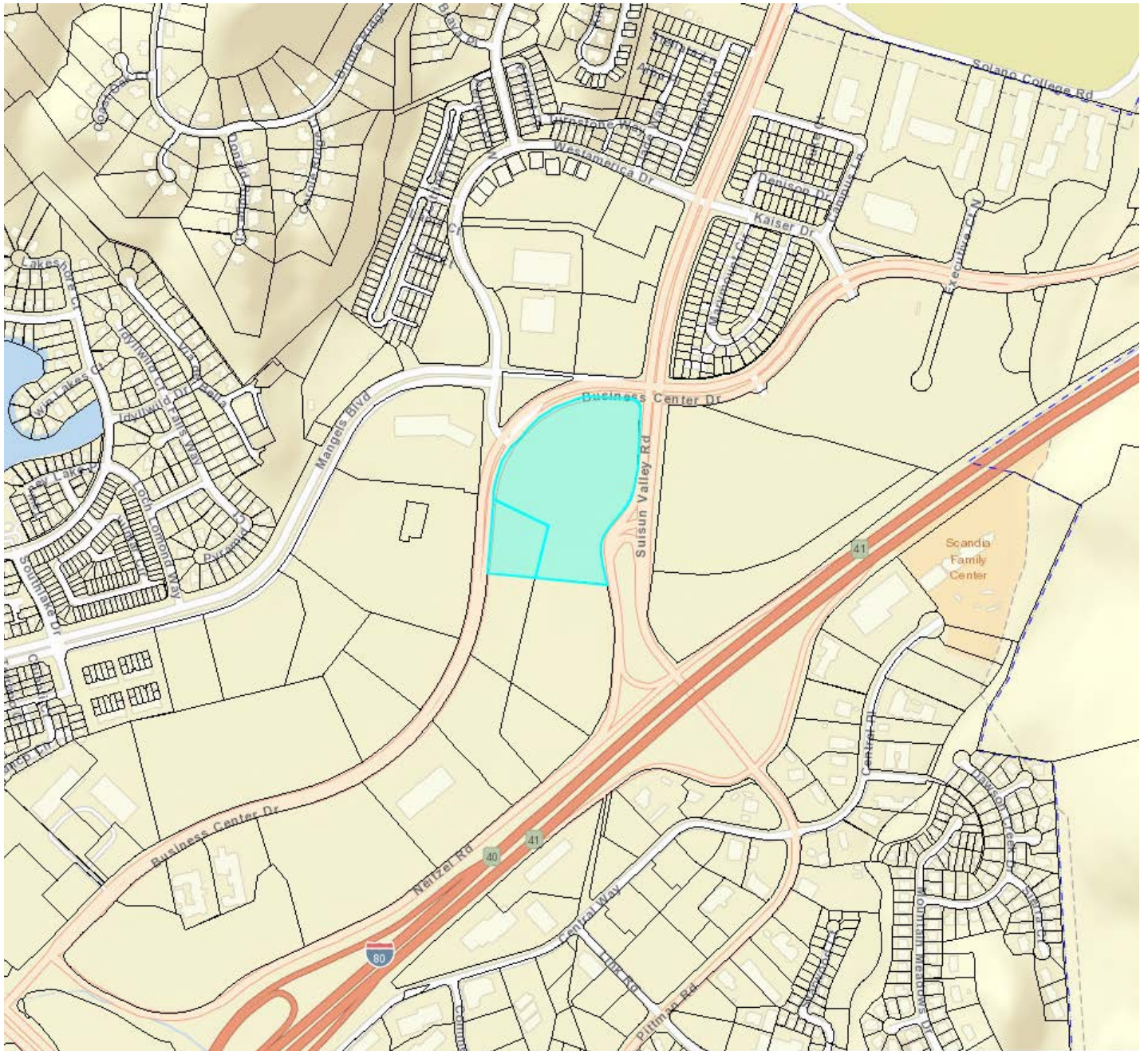

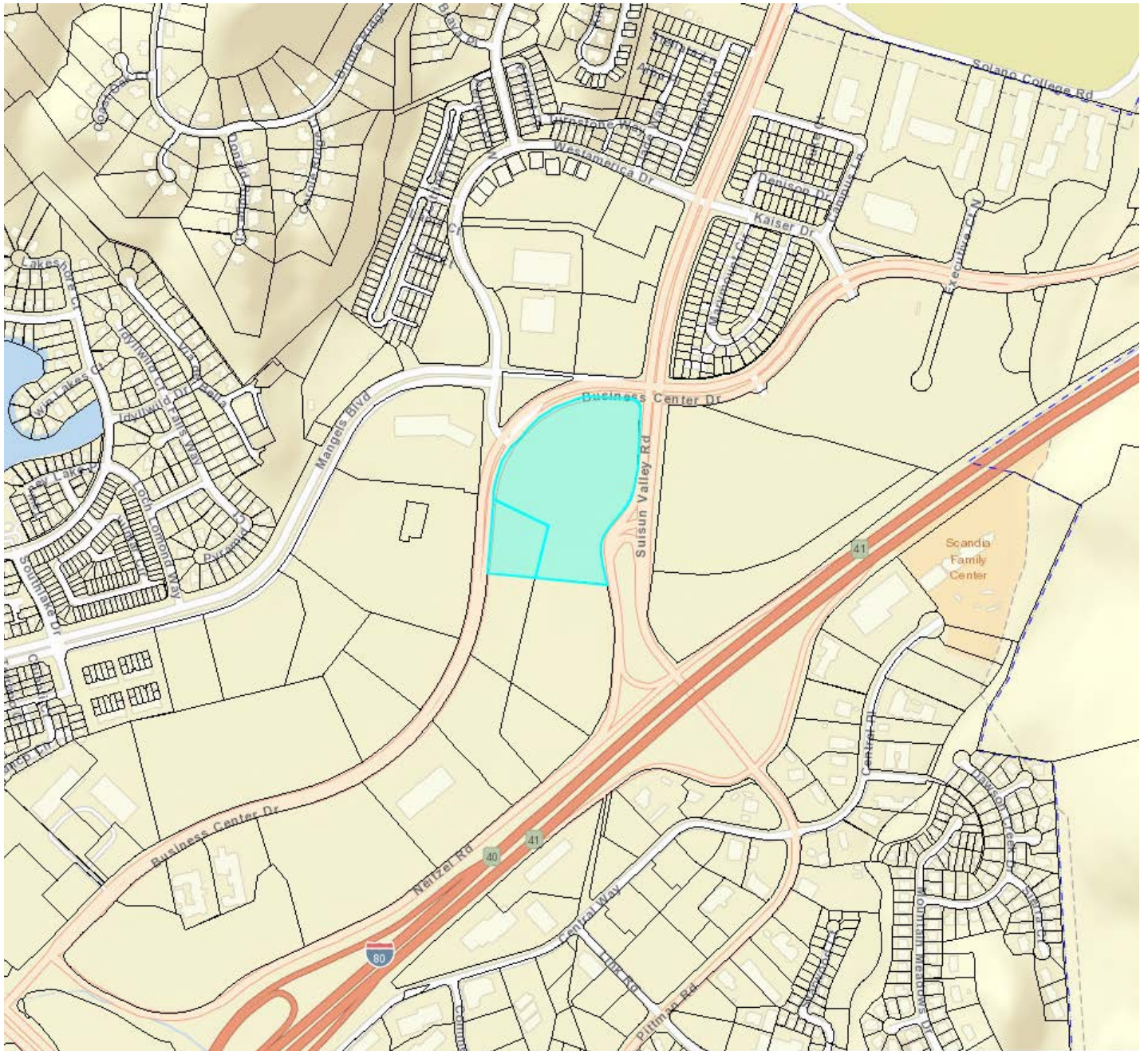
