**Project Location (include county):** City-owned, managed or leased properties including Malibu Bluffs Park, Trancas Canyon Park, Malibu Equestrian Park, Las Flores Creek Park, Legacy Park, City Hall, the median on Pacific Coast Highway between Webb Way and Cross Creek Road; the planter at Civic Center Way and Malibu Canyon Road; the median on John Tyler Drive and Pacific Coast Highway; the Civic Center Wastewater Treatment Facility; and Super Care Drugs/Malibu Medical.

**Project Description:** The project replaced the City's Integrated Pest Management (IPM) program and organic-only pesticides pilot program with a more restrictive Earth Friendly Management Policy (EFMP) for several City-owned, managed or leased properties. The EFMP is an ecosystem-based strategy that applies scientific and organic approaches in coordination with pest monitoring to effectively manage City property. Treatment methods are required to avoid the application of toxic pesticides and trapping of ground rodents to manage these areas.
