PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The GSWC proposes to install an ion exchange treatment system (IX System) to remove nitrate from water extracted from existing groundwater wells (Bradshaw Well 2,10, and 14). Bradshaw Well 2 will be a backup source of supply in the event either Well 10 or Well 14 be out of service for mechanical/electrical issues. The proposed Project will be contained on existing GSWC property where the existing wells are located. Water pumped from Bradshaw wells 10, and 14 have a nitrate concentration of approximately 11 and 10 milligram/Liter (mg/L) respectively which exceed the Maximum Containment Levels of 10 mg/L. Nitrate treatment for Bradshaw wells 10 (1200 gallon per minute [gpm]), and 14 (1000 gpm) is required for the delivery of potable water from these wells to the distribution system. Installing treatment will allow the use of Bradshaw Wells 10 & 14 to provide potable water to existing customers.

PUBLIC AGENCY APPROVING PROJECT AND CARRYING OUT PROJECT; This is to advise that the State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board) has determined that the Project is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act and will issue a drinking water supply permit for the operation of the above described Project.
