Project Location: Section of the levee top road along the Sacramento River from Garcia Bend Park to approximately the intersection of the levee road and Arabella Lane. The proposed trail would connect with the existing paved Sacramento River Parkway Trail which extends along the levee from Garcia Bend Park south to the City limits.

County: Sacramento

Project Description: The proposed project would pave 1.85 miles of the Sacramento Levee maintenance road to allow bicycle and pedestrian use of the levee road. The purpose of the project is to improve the existing levee maintenance road to also serve as a Class I multi-use trail connectivity for local and regional recreation and commuter travel.
