<u>Project Description</u>: The project involves recordation of a Land Use Covenant (LUC) for the Long Beach Memorial Medical Center (LBMMC) – Operable Unit 3 (Site). The cleanup decision document, referred to as a Soil and Soil Vapor Investigation Report (Report), summarized investigation activities and analysis for total petroleum hydrocarbons (TPH), metals, methane, and volatile organic compounds. Recordation of the LUC will restrict the Site to commercial/industrial land uses and establish Site conditions that will prevent exposure of future users to residual contaminants left in soil located outside of the footprint for a potential new proposed office building.

A Soll and Soll Vapor Investigation Report identified that TPH as vapor was detected in subsurface vapor probes located at the northwest corner of the Site. The vapor TPH concentration in the 5-foot probe at the northwest corner of the Site exceed the San Francisco Regional Water Quality Control Board commercial/industrial environmental screening levels in two out of three samples. Based on the results of the investigation, the Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) determined that a LUC is necessary for the Site. Specifically, the intent of the LUC is to restrict the property to commercial/industrial land uses and to establish conditions that prevent exposure to residual contaminants left in place at the northwest corner of the Site if future buildings were to be constructed in this area.

The City of Long Beach previously approved the LBMMC Expansion project. On September 1, 2005 the City of Long Beach approved the Long Beach Memorial Medical Center Expansion, Volume I, Draft and Final Environmental Impact Report (EIR) for the LBMMC Expansion project which includes analysis of potential impacts related to contaminated soils at the Site. The EIR included mitigation measures addressing aesthetics, air quality, cultural resources, geology/soils, hazards/hazardous materials, hydrology/water quality, land use/planning, noise, public services, transportation/traffic, and utilities/service systems. Since the recordation of a LUC is within the LBMMC Expansion project, DTSC, as a California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Responsible Agency, is utilizing the EIR for the Report CEQA analysis.
