Project consists of the restoration of manholes, installation of upgraded sewer dines for sewer deficiencies and capacity replacement, pipe repair, lift station rehabilitation, pump system rehabilitation, headworks rehabilitation, replacement of clean digesters, replacement of the belt filter presses and conveyor, Plant Motor Central Panel replacement, upgrades to electrical, installation of odor control devices, site security improvements, and storm water site improvements (Reference: City of Oxnard CIP Improvement Plan, dated 2017)
