Caltrans submitted a Notice of Preparation of the Environmental Impact Report for the Alamo Pintado Pedestrian Bridge project, which was posted by your office on May 18, 2017. With this letter Caltrans is requesting that the Notice of Preparation be withdrawn and is advising that Caltrans will no longer be preparing an Environmental Impact Report for this project. The project scope has changed from bridge removal to bridge replacement since the original Class of Action was determined. The change in scope to include a bridge replacement has alleviated much of the public concern related to this project.
