Project Location: The Project is located in the City of Victorville, and within San Bernardino County, California. Specifically, it is located at the southwesterly corner of the US-395/Palmdale Road (SR-18) intersection.

Project Description: The proposed Project would involve the development of approximately 96,300 square feet of commercial/retail uses on an approximately 14.8-acre site. The current site plan concept configures the Project uses as 10 pads.

Discretionary actions associated with the Project include:

- · Certification of the Desert Grove Retail Project EIR;
- Approval of Tentative Parcel Map(s);
- · Approval(s) of Conditional Use Permits;
- Site Plan Approval(s);

· Various other City of Victorville construction, grading, and encroachment permits.

Environmental Topics Evaluated: The Draft EIR examines the potential impacts generated by the proposed project in relation to the following environmental topics: Air Quality; Biological Resources; Cultural Resources/Tribal Cultural Resources; Geology and Soils; Greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions impacts; Hazards and Hazardous Materials; Hydrology and Water Quality; Land Use and Planning; Noise; and Transportation/Traffic.

Significant Environmental Impacts: Based on the analysis in the Draft EIR, the Project would have significant and unavoidable impacts to air quality, and traffic, as identified below and described in detail in DEIR Sections 4.3, and 4.2, respectively.
