## West Capitol Avenue Road Rehabilitation Project – Initial Study/Mitigated Negative Declaration (IS/MND)

Dear Mr. Ramirez:

Thank you for including California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) in the application review for the project referenced above. Caltrans' new mission, vision, and goals signal a modernization of our approach to California's transportation system. We review this local development for impacts to the State Highway System (SHS) in keeping with our mission, vision and goals for sustainability/livability/economy, and safety/heath. We provide these comments consistent with the state's mobility goals that support a vibrant economy and build communities.

The West Capitol Avenue Road Rehabilitation Project (Project) limits include West Capitol Avenue between Enterprise Boulevard and Jefferson Boulevard and along Jefferson Boulevard between West Capitol Avenue and Park Boulevard. The project would rehabilitate the roadway surface, make safety improvements, add bike lanes, add enhanced pedestrian crossings, improve lighting, and upgraded traffic signalization at various intersections along West Capitol Avenue and Jefferson Boulevard. Based on the information provided, Caltrans provides the following comments:

## Traffic Operations

Caltrans requests the opportunity to review the proposed traffic management plan and lane closure plan to evaluate potential impacts to the SHS at the following locations:

- Eastbound Interstate 80 (I-80) off-ramp to Enterprise Boulevard.
- Westbound I-80 off-ramp to West Capitol Avenue.
- Westbound U.S. Highway 50 (US 50) off-ramp to Jefferson Boulevard.
- Westbound US 50 off-ramp to Harbor Boulevard.

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## **Encroachment Permit**

An encroachment permit will be required from the Caltrans for any work performed on the State Right of Way (ROW) if not previously obtained. To apply, a completed encroachment permit application, environmental documentation, and five sets of plans clearly indicating State ROW must be submitted to:
