The Project involves legislative actions to change the permitted land use type on 47.5 acres from residential to industrial. Also, a three-building industrial park containing 1,121,380-s.f. of warehousing and supporting office space is proposed on the site. Physical improvements would include surface parking areas, vehicle drive aisles, landscaping, water quality/detention basin, utility infrastructure, exterior lighting, walls, fencing and signage. The Project entails the approval of a General Plan Amendment, Specific Plan Amendment, Zone Change, Tentative Parcel Map, Design Review, & Development Agreement. **Assessor Parcel Numbers: 0255-091-09, -12, -13, -14, -15, -21 through -27, -29, -32, -33, -41, -46 through -49, -54 through -57, -61, and -62.
