The California Department of Water Resources (DWR) staff has reviewed the city of Colton's Initial Study and Mitigated Negative Declaration (IS/MND) for the Ashley Way Logistics Center Project IS/MND. As a responsible agency, DWR appreciates the opportunity to provide comments and inform you that portions of the proposed project encroach on DWR's right-of-way.

Specifically, the western edge of the project lies within the right-of-way for DWR's Santa Ana Pipeline (SAPL), part of the State Water Project (SWP). The IS/MND for the proposed project describes grading, paving and landscaping elements to be constructed within SWP right-of-way and over the SAPL. Water Code Section 12899 and California Code of Regulations, Title 23, Division 2, Chapter 6, Articles 1 - 10 detail the requirement that any proposed encroachments or construction within SWP right-of-way shall first get written authorization from DWR, regardless of whether the State owns fee title or has an easement, license, permit, or joint use agreement.
