Project Location - Specific: The geographic scope of this project includes the Forsythe Creek H 12: 180101100201 and 180101100202), which includes Forsythe Creek and its tributaries, and the West Fork Russian River (West Fork) and its tributaries; all of which lie within the community of Redwood Valley. The West Fork is the eastern component of the Forsythe Creek HSA, encompassing approximately 22,000 acres. The Forsythe Creek watershed encompasses approximately 32,000 acres. Of the area within the Forsythe Creek HSA, approximately 21,000 acres (~38%) burned during the Redwood Fire of October 2017 (CAL FIRE Burn Severity Map, 2017).

Description of Nature, Purpose, and Beneficiaries of Project: Tree planting using native conifers, oaks, and willows as appropriate, would occur on approximately 240 acres of burned hillslopes that suffered moderate to high burn severity in the Redwood Complex Fire. Reforestation efforts will be conducted using hand crews. Project treatments aim to provide accelerated, native vegetative cover within the fire footprint to protect water quality.
