Existing structures will be replaced with a new 8 million gallon reservoir, 925 square foot operations building, 1,950 square foot pump station control building, water treatment system, and related ancillary facilities. The new reservoir structure will be sited in approximately the same footprint as the existing reservoir and the elevation of the roof of the replacement reservoir will be approximately 1 foot higher than existing. Related ancillary facilities will include: an enclosed diesel standby generator, a ground-level transformer, underground mainline piping and access vaults. Construction for the new reservoir will require removal of the on-site groundcover, shrubs and trees. Replacement landscaping will include native southern California plants and shrubs with low water requirements. The perimeter of the site will be secured with a variable height metal picket fence and security access gates on the northeast, southeast and southwest corners.
