The economizers will help improve the efficiency of the facility's boilers by reducing energy demands, which will lead to subsequent greenhouse gas reductions.

14 C.C.R. §15301: The project involves minor alteration of existing structures and mechanical equipment. Heat recovery exchanger systems on exhaust gas stacks will be installed at existing food processing facilities. The economizers will reduce emissions of existing boiler equipment. These installations will be minor alterations to the structures and equipment, with no expansion beyond the existing use of the food processing facilities and will not have significant effect on the environment.
