
Dear Mr. Wolfin,

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) appreciates the opportunity to review and comment on the Bureau of Indian Affairs Notice of (Non-Gaming) Land Acquisition Application for the Jackson Band of Miwuk Indians, SCH #2019050001 in the City of Jackson. The Jackson Band of Miwuk Indians would like to transfer the property located at 15701 Coventry Court with APN: 042-182-004-000 to Indian trust. Transferring land from private ownership to Indian trust removes the land from the property tax roll and essentially exempts it from State and local codes and regulations. APN 042-182-004-000 is located on the West side of existing Jackson band of Miwuk Indians trust lands.

Caltrans has no comments on this project. However, if future developments are proposed, Caltrans requests to be included in the review process.
