Project Title: Dry Creek Gravel Accumulation Management (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2019-0023-R2)

Project Location: The project is located at Dry Creek, in the County of Yolo, State of California; Latitude 38.5256306, Longitude -121.9929556; Section 20, Township 08N, Range 01W of the Mt. Diablo Meridian, US Geological Survey (USGS) 7.5 guad Winters.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2019-0023-R2, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to Ernie Gaddini.

The project is limited to use of a paddle wheel excavator to remove no more than 300 cubic yards annually of accumulated gravel from the bed of Dry Creek for purposes of minimizing excess bank erosion due to channel aggradation resulting from the accumulated gravel. The excavated gravel will then be repurposed by spreading on various farm roads to eliminate excessive rutting caused by movement of heavy farm machinery during the course of normal farming operations.
