8' wildlife fencing to replace the current Caltrans Right of Way fencing, wildlife escape ramps and passageways within the concrete median barrier

 Tree/vegetation removal will be required at the proposed location of the 12 x12 box culvert, as well as along the ROW fence line to install new wildlife fencing

Tree/vegetation removal may also be required at the proposed wildlife escape ramp locations for construction

Environmental Commitments

 If vegetation removal during construction is required during bird nesting season (February 1 – September 31), a preconstruction nesting survey is required. Standard Specification 14-6.03B

ESAs are present. Mapping will be provided to demarcate sensitive areas to be avoided. Standard specification 14-1.02
