Biological Avoldance Measures:

Prior to construction, if construction activities are proposed to occur during the typical nesting season (February 15 to September 1) within potential nesting habitat within the project area, a nesting bird survey shall be conducted by a qualified biologist at least two weeks prior to construction to determine presence/absence of nesting birds within the project area. Work activities shall be avoided within 150 ft of active bird nests, until a qualified biologist has determined that young birds have fledged and left the nest. Readily visible exclusion zones shall be established in areas where nests must be avoided. USFWS and CDFW shall be contacted for additional guidance if nesting birds are observed within or near the boundaries of the project site. Active nests shall not be disturbed and eggs, or young of birds covered by the Migratory Bird Treaty Act (MBTA) and California Fish and Wildlife Code shall not be killed, injured, or harassed at any time.

- All construction related work shall occur during the dry season (April 1-November 1). To avoid impacts to California Tiger Salamander (Ambystoma californiense).
- Work shall not occur when rain totals exceed .25 inch during a 24-hour period. Work shall not resume until the National Weather Service (NWS) predicts less than 30% chance of rain for a 72-hour forecast for the Project area.
- Stop work on the project and notify the Engineer immediately upon discovery of a regulated species. The Engineer will
 contact a Department Biologist Paul Holmes (805) 549-3811 for the purposes of coordinating with resource agencies.
- 4. Staging Areas, Equipment and Material Storage: To avoid impacts to adjacent native vegetation and wildlife, all staging and equipment and material storage areas shall occur in existing pullouts or at currently paved locations. No vegetation clearing on public or private land is allowed to create storage sites without first being cleared through Caltrans.
