Managed Network Service contract is on a flexible month-to-month basis. However, if interrupted, the service agreement coverage of installation, equipment upgrades, replacements and maintenance cannot be renewed at the same rate.

Overview

ValleyInternet will connect the barn and nursery/garden locations with wireless point to point links.

A 2TB Network Video Recorder (NVR) will be located in a locking network rack cabinet in the garage. 1080p optical zoom cameras with IR capability will be located at the barn (1), nursery (1) and garden (3). (see survey and diagram details below)
