CNU currently operates a pharmacy and medical college at 9700 West Taron Dr. and an approximately 15,000-square-foot event center in the office building at 9650 West Taron Dr. At buildout, the Project will consist of an expanded pharmacy and medical college, new medical center (hospital) with a helistop, an out-patient clinic, a medical office building, two parking structures with general retail/personal service/restaurant use, a dormitory, another parking structure with roof-top sports facilities, a central plant and mechanical yard, public gathering spaces, and surface parking. The Project would require demolition of several existing buildings and would be implemented in three phases.
