NOTICE OF EXEMPTION FROM CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT ("CEQA")

PROJECT LOCATION:

Tidewater Use Area at Martin Luther King Jr. Regional Shoreline

PROJECT LOCATION: Tidewater Avenue, Oakland, CA 94601

PROJECT PURPOSE & DESCRIPTION: The project would implement the plan for a 7.13-acre park as conceptually described in the City of Oakland's Central Estuary Area Plan and associated Supplemental Environmental Impact Report (EIR), certified by the City of Oakland on June 18, 2013. Activities include the removal of concrete paving, installation of 12-inch deep gravel pavement for a parking lot accommodating 122 parking spaces, grading of the 7.13-acre site to ensure flat surfaces and proper drainage, and installation of fencing, a restroom with four flush toilets, and a nature play area with play equipment. Up to 22,000 cubic yards of clean fill would be imported as it is available, which is estimated to occur gradually over an approximately one-year period. No cut or soil export is proposed.

The project is expected to begin construction in 2020 and is anticipated to extend over a 1.5-year period during the dry season and outside of bird nesting season. All temporary construction staging would occur on the project site. Site preparation and construction work would occur consistent with the City of Oakland noise regulations as identified in Standard Condition of Approval 28 identified in the Certified EIR, which is generally limited to Monday through Friday during the hours between 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. The Park District will follow Bay Area Air Quality Management District (BAAQMD) regulations for dust control, and waste disposal will be collected and taken to a certified waste disposal site.

**DETERMINATION:** EBRPD has reviewed the project and determined it to be categorically exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to the following sections of CEQA and the CEQA Guidelines:

14 CCR Section 15304 (Minor Alterations to Land). Grading will be on land with a slope of less than 10 percent, and will not be in a waterway, in any wetland, in an officially designated (by federal, state, or local government action) scenic area, or in officially mapped areas of severe geologic hazard such as an Alquist-Priolo Earthquake Fault Zone or within an official Seismic Hazard Zone, as delineated by the State Geologist. A May 2018 geotechnical report confirmed that the project site is not within a seismic hazard zone. The project would include filling of earth into previously excavated land with material compatible with the natural features of the site.

14 CCR Section 15183 (Projects Consistent with a Community Plan, General Plan, or Zoning). This project is consistent with the City of Oakland's Central Estuary Area Plan, associated Supplemental Environmental Impact Report (Supplemental EIR), associated General Plan amendment to designate the project site as Parks, and associated zoning changes to designate the zoning as Open Space-Regional.

14 CCR Section 15300.2 (Exceptions). None of the exceptions to the exemptions apply to the project (i.e., site is an urbanized area with no sensitive habitat, no cumulative impacts, no unusual circumstances, no scenic highways, no historical resources, and no hazardous materials.)


