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MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION, AVENTINE AT SWEETWATER SPRINGS, SPRING VALLEY

Dear Ms. Russell:

The Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) has received the submitted Negative Declaration with an Initial Study for the above-mentioned project. The project proposes to develop 92 detached condominium units on a 10.57-acre land that currently houses a shopping center.

Section IX of the Initial Study states that investigations conducted at a former drycleaning business identified that PCE and TCE were detected in soil vapor at levels that exceed residential screening levels. Therefore, remediation (excavation) will be conducted through a soil management plan under the oversight of the County Department of Environmental Health, Site Assessment and Mitigation Program.

DTSC recommends the following comments be addressed in the Environmental Impact Report (EIR), Section IX, Hazards and Hazardous Materials:

 Discuss the extent of the PCE and TCE contamination. Extent of releases of the volatile organic compounds should be fully defined to determine whether the groundwater is impacted. If the groundwater is impacted, groundwater remediation or monitoring should be proposed. Ms. Denise Russel July 18, 2019 Page 2

After the excavation of the impacted soil, a cumulative human health risk
assessment including vapor intrusion should be conducted to ensure that the site
is remediated to meet the residential land use. DTSC's modified screening levels
