Project Location: The projects are located on un-named Class I and II tributaries of Lacey Creek, which flow to Webber Lake in Sierra County, State of California. The projects are located in Sections 5 and 7 of Township 18N, Range 14E; and Sections 21, 28, 29, 32, and 33 of Township 19N, Range 14E; U.S. Geological Survey (USGS) Quad map Webber Peak; Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.

Project Description: The projects are limited to the installation of one permanent rocked ford crossing (1); eight temporary rocked ford crossings (9, 19, 20, 21, 22, 24, 27, and 34); and use of one water drafting site (WH-1). Further information can be found in the Timber Harvesting Plan (THP) 2-18-00130-SIE.
