Project Description:

Seven exploratory test borings would be conducted in the existing City right-of-way (AC pavement or concrete bridge deck) to assess conditions for the proposed Camino Del Mar Bridge replacement. This exploratory field testing and sampling would help confirm the physical properties of the material where the replacement bridge piers and abutments would be located. The data collection activity over 7 days would not result in a serious or major disturbance to public access or an environmental resource.

Reasons why Project is Exempt:

Measures are being incorporated to ensure no impacts to sensitive resources. A steel casing unit used at the bridge deck would be sealed to prevent any water or soil material from leaking. Material would be retrieved using a vacuum system and mud circulation box on plastic sheeting to prevent overspill. A qualified biologist will confirm absence of sensitive animal species prior to commencing drilling to avoid indirect noise impacts. No sensitive biological resources/habitat are located in boring locations.

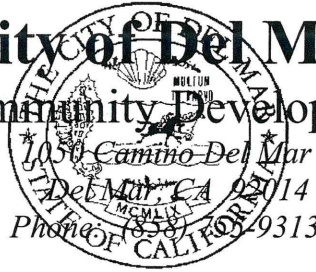
