Scope of work:

The project proposes to remove and replace the existing deck and approaching slab polyester concrete overlay due to rutting caused by chain wear within the Caltrans Right-of-Way on State Route 49 (SR-49) in Sierra County, and Interstate Highway 80 (I-80) in Nevada and Placer Counties.

Staging

Staging has not been identified in the project description above or in the current project plans. If staging is identified outside the current project study limits, it must be cleared by either Caltrans Environmental Staff or contractor provided Environmental specialists. Documentation must be provided to Caltrans Environmental staff for approval. Per Design Information Bulletin Number 85, Guidance for the Consideration of Material Disposal, Staging, and Borrow Sites, Original signed by Mark Leja, Division Chief, Division of Design, May 15, 2007and Section 7-103 Protection of Environmental Resources, in Chapter 7 of the August 2006 Caltrans Construction Manual the contractor will provide to Caltrans environmental documentation prepared by appropriately qualified environmental specialists. The contractor will also obtain or update all necessary permits, licenses, and agreements including supporting environmental documents from appropriate regulatory and governmental agencies.
