**Project Title:** Bohemian Grove Non-Industrial Timber Management Plan (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2018-0278-R3)

**Project Location:** The project is on Class II and Class III watercourse tributaries to the Russian River, Sonoma County; Portions of Sections 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 16, 17, 18, Township 7N, Range 10W, U.S. Geological Survey (USGS) map Camp Meeker, Mt. Diablo base and meridian.
