The proposed project would include 18 buildings with 203 market rate dwelling units in row houses, town homes, and mixed-use residential units, 39 senior living units, up to 20,000 square feet of first floor retail space, and associated below and at-grade parking stalls. Development of the proposed project would involve demolition of the existing structures and parking stalls on site, including some existing on-site vegetation, and construction of the project buildings and infrastructure.
