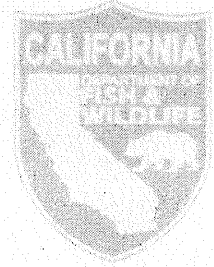

Project Title: Storm Damage Repair Laytonville-Dos Rios Rd MP0.99 and 1.01 (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2019-0090-R1)

Project Location: The project is approximately 0.6 miles east of Laytonville, at mileposts (MP) 0.99 and 1.01 on Dos Rios Road, in the County of Mendocino, State of California; Section 7, Township 21N, Range 14W; Mt. Diablo Base and Meridian, in the Laytonville, Calif. U.S. Geological Survey 7.5-minute quadrangle. Latitude 39.69127°, Longitude -123.47138°.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2019-0090-R1, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to Mendocino County Department of Transportation, represented by Howard Dashiell.

The project is limited to two encroachments. At MP 0.99, the project will shorten the culvert at the outlet end and a small amount of rock for energy dissipation. At MP 1.01, the project will replace the existing culvert, and add rock slope protection to areas of failing bank and road edge.

Reasons why project is exempt: The modifies and replaces existing structures, and adds rock slope protection. There would be no significant adverse impact on endangered, rare or threatened species or their habitat pursuant to section 15065. The project is a minor alteration to land, water, and vegetation, and does not remove any trees.
