Project Title: Hidden Glen (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2019-0127-R3)

Project Location: The project is located at an unnamed channel, in the County of Contra Costa, State of California; Latitude 37.976688, Longitude -121.751116; Assessor's Parcel Number 053-060-031.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2019-0127-R3, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Arcadia Development Company.

The project will move an existing gas pipeline running perpendicular to Laurel Road, grade and fill the channel, wetland, and riparian habitat, and extend the culvert and road to the Arcadia property boundary.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the above described project on July 17, 2019 and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will / will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
