

NOTICE OF INTENT TO ADOPT A NEGATIVE DECLARATION

Notice is hereby given that the County of Fresno has prepared Initial Study Application (IS) No. 7663 pursuant to the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act for the following proposed project:

INITIAL STUDY APPLICATION NO. 7663, proposing to approve the disposition (sale) of 32.59 acres of surplus government property identified as the University Medical Center Campus, allow for the creation of a 4.32-acre parcel to be retained by the County of Fresno as sole and separate property, and the lease-back of 14 on-site structures to the County. The subject site is located in the City of Fresno PI (Public Institutions) Zone District at the northeasterly intersection of S. Cedar Avenue, and E. Kings Canyon Avenue within the city limits of the City of Fresno (SUP. DIST. 3) (APN 461-020-03T). (Addressed as 445 S. Cedar, 496 S. Barton, 500 S. Barton, 4361 E. Kings Canyon, 4409 E. Inyo, 4411 E. Kings Canyon, and 4460 E. Huntington). Adopt the Negative Declaration prepared for Initial Study Application No. 7663 and take action on the sale of surplus County of Fresno real property.

(hereafter, the "Proposed Project")

The County of Fresno has determined that it is appropriate to adopt a Negative Declaration for the Proposed Project. The purpose of this Notice is to (1) provide notice of the availability of IS Application No. 7663 and the draft Negative Declaration, and request written comments thereon; and (2) provide notice of the public hearing regarding the Proposed Project.

The County of Fresno will receive written comments on the Proposed Project and Negative Declaration from August 23, 2019 through September 23, 2019.
