The reservoir would remain full only during the months of February, March and April. During "non-frost" months (May through January), the reservoir would be kept at or below a design depth that will allow for normal operation of the vineyard drip irrigation system. Twelve (12) emergency egress ladders would be installed to prevent accidental human and animal drowning. Access to the site would continue to be provided by an existing all-weather access road from Alisos Canyon Rd.
