Project Title: Orangewood Avenue Improvement Project (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2019-0048-R5)

Project Location (include county): The project is located within the City of Anaheim, County of Orange, California; Latitude 33°47'45.19"N, Longitude - 117°52'45.28"W. The streambed alteration/construction will be from bank to bank within the Santa Ana River Channel, under the Orangewood Avenue Bridge.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2019-0048-R5, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, City of Anaheim as represented by Stephen Cruz.

The project proposes to widen Orangewood Avenue from a four-lane roadway to a six-lane divided facility to provide expanded vehicle, bicycle, and pedestrian access. The project would incorporate an additional through lane in each direction of travel through the project site boundaries. To widen the roadway, the project would widen the existing Orangewood Avenue bridge structure over the Santa Ana River. Bridge widening improvements would involve widening the bridge an additional 30-35 feet to accommodate the proposed six travel lanes and associated sidewalk. Five (5) existing bents will be lengthened for the widening. The bents are situated along the River bottom. The proposed total bridge length would be 348 feet, six inches. In addition, articulated concrete block mats will be installed 12 feet below the channel invert to provide scour protection.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the above described project on 7/2/19 and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will / will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the environmental impact report prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures were / were not made a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.
4. A mitigation reporting or monitoring plan was / was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
5. A statement of overriding considerations was / was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
6. Findings were / were not made by CDFW pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15091.
