**PROJECT LOCATION:** The Project is in the community of Thornton, in San Joaquin County, California. Modifications to existing wastewater facilities are located within Thornton. The force main connection would extend along Thornton Road and Barber Road, from Thornton to the Sacramento Area Sewer District (SASD) pump station (S0147) located on the west side of Cameron Road, north of Barber. The Project area is shown on the United States Geological Survey's (USGS) Thornton, California, 7.5-minute quadrangle map within the New Hope Tract in Townships 4 and 5 North, Range 5 East.

**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:** The Project consists of the decommissioning of the County's existing treatment facilities, construction of a new pump station; and construction of a 2.2-mile long, 8-inch force main from Thornton to existing the SASD Sewer Pump Station, S0147.

This is to advise that the State Water Board made the following California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) determinations and approved CWSRF financing on August 30, 2019 for the Project:

1. Determinations were made pursuant to the CEQA.
2. The State Water Board considered the Initial Study/Mitigated Negative Declaration (MND) as prepared by the Applicant for this Project.
