Location: Madera County, San Joaquin River, near Summer Hill


Description: Geotechnical surveys for the design of the project to replace two adjoining water diversion facilities on the San Joaquin River with a single common diversion facility. The State Lands Commission action is an approval of a Geological Survey Permit through July 1, 2019.

This is to advise that the California State Lands Commission, as Lead Agency Responsible Agency, approved the above described project on April 5, 2019, and made the following determinations regarding the project.

- 1) The project will will not have a significant effect on the environment.
- 2) An Environmental Impact Report (EIR) was prepared and certified pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.
- 3) Mitigation measures were were not made a condition of the approval of the project.
- 4) A mitigation reporting or monitoring plan was or was not adopted for this project.
