Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Amendment No. 7, a major amendment to the already amended Streambed Alteration Agreement (SAA) number 1600-2013-0194-R4, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the Project Applicant, California Department of Transportation (Caltrans).

The Project involves activities related to roadway realignment and widening work on SR 180 where it crosses over the Centerville-Kingsburg Canal, China Slough, Collins Creek, the Kings River, Cameron Slough, Byrd Slough, the Carmelita Canal, and the Mount Campbell Canal. This Major Amendment No. 7 amends the Agreement reflecting changes to the planned water diversion at Collins Creek.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the above described Project on 5/14/19 and has made the following determinations regarding the Project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):
