### **Project Description:**

As approved and reflected in the current master plan, the Project would involve development on the project site through a public-private partnership of up to four office buildings of two to six stories clustered around pedestrian plazas and courtyards and surrounded by parking facilities. The Project would provide 722 surface parking spaces, as well as 402 parking spaces in a three-story parking structure located in the northeast part of the site, for a total of 1,124 parking spaces. The office buildings would total approximately 283,500 square feet on the 12.5 (net) acre project site.

Minor changes to the Project analyzed in the adopted Final IS-MND are proposed. This document was approved by the CSU Board of Trustees on September 10, 2014. The Modified Project reflects a revision to Phase 1/Building 1 of the Original Project to develop approximately 64,457 square feet of building to be occupied by community college classroom space. This would be supported by approximately 495 surface parking spaces, all on 5.57 acres of the total 12.5 acre project site. While this building is under construction, the parking lot areas of the site would be developed and modular buildings would be placed on the northern portion of the parking lot to accommodate the community college classroom space until completion of the building. Once the building is completed and occupied by the community college, these modular buildings would be removed from the site. The remainder of the project site outside the 5.57 acre Phase 1/Building 1 area would remain available for future development as envisioned in the Original Project.

This is to advise that the California State University as the lead agency approved the above-described project on April 15, 2019 and have made the following determinations regarding the project:

- 1. An Addendum to the Final IS-MND was prepared for this project pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.
- 2. The Addendum to the Final IS-MND concluded that the modifications to the proposed project would not result in new significant environmental effects or a substantial increase in the severity of previously identified significant effects beyond those previously identified in the Final IS-MND.
- 3. No new mitigation measures were made a condition of the approval of this project.
- 4. A mitigation monitoring program was originally adopted for this project.
- 5. Findings and a Statement of Overriding Considerations were not adopted for the modifications to the proposed project since significant impacts were not identified.
