Project Title: Wright Solar Park Project (Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2018-0149-R4)

Project Location (include county): The Project is located at an unnamed ephemeral stream, approximately 2.7 miles southeast of the unincorporated community of Santa Nella and approximately 6 miles southwest of the City of Los Banos in the County of Merced, California; Latitude 37° 1'37.93"N, Longitude 120°57'48.56"W.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2018-0149-R4, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Wright Solar Park, LLC.

The Project is part of a larger solar development. The Project authorized under this Agreement is limited to a single access road crossing over one (1) unnamed ephemeral stream. The Project includes the installation of four (4) new corrugated metal pipe culverts and improvements to an existing native soil farm road to create an aggregate base access road for a length of 251 feet.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the above described project on 8-7-19 and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will / will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the environmental impact report prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures were / were not made a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.
