Following conifer treatments and prescribed fire, the Tribe will implement long-term cultural management for riparian habitat enhancement and stream environment zone restoration, including the propagation and planting of culturally-significant meadow and riparian plants in key meadow locations. The meadow will be treated using a combination of mechanical and hand treatments.

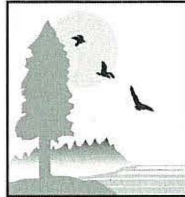

**CEQA Project Title:** San Onofre Nuclear Generating Station (SONGS) Units 2 & 3 Decommissioning Project**Lead Agency Discretionary Approval:** Termination of existing California State Lands Commission (Commission or CSLC) General Lease – Industrial Use and Issuance of 16-year General Lease – Industrial Use through March 20, 2035 for use of CSLC Lease Facilities, including offshore riprap and CSLC Lease Offshore Activities associated with the Project.**Proponent:** Southern California Edison Company, San Diego Gas & Electric Company, City of Riverside and the City of Anaheim**Location:** The Project's offshore portion (CSLC Lease Offshore Activities) lies on State sovereign land under the jurisdiction of the Commission; the onshore Project site lies entirely within the boundaries of the Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton, approximately 51 miles north-northwest of the city of San Diego, San Diego County, California.**Description:** The Project involves decontamination, dismantlement, and removal of certain above- and below-grade facilities at SONGS to meet the Nuclear Regulatory Commission's requirements for unrestricted use; disposition of the Units 2 & 3 offshore conduits; and removal of navigational and environmental monitoring buoys and anchors. These activities would take place from 2019 through 2028. The portion of the Project within Commission jurisdiction is located on sovereign land and is defined as the CSLC Lease Offshore Activities; these activities include disposition of two offshore intake conduits and two offshore discharge conduits, and removal of two primary offshore intake structures, two auxiliary offshore intake structures, 12 diffusers, 23 manhole access port structures, one fish return conduit, and five monitoring and navigational buoys.
