

Project Title: Pope Water Diversion and Stream Crossings Project (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2017-0763-R1)

Project Location (include county): The project to be completed is located within the Thompson Creek watershed, approximately 4.4 miles south/southwest of the town of Dinsmore, County of Humboldt, State of California. The project is located in Section 26, T1N, R5E, Humboldt Base and Meridian; in the Dinsmore U.S. Geological Survey 7.5-minute quadrangle; Assessor's Parcel Number 210-117-022; latitude 40.4345, N and longitude -123.5758 W.

Project Description: The project is limited to three encroachments. The first encroachment is a water diversion from a spring. Water is diverted for cannabis cultivation irrigation and domestic use. Work for the water diversion will include use and maintenance of the water diversion infrastructure. The two other proposed encroachments are to conduct work on existing culverts. Work for these encroachments will include the clearing of inlets and outlets as well as the installation of rock armoring as necessary to minimize erosion.
