Project Title: Lovatto Water Diversion and Stream Crossing Project (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2019-0024-R1)

Project Location: The project to be completed is located within the Mattole River watershed, approximately 0.8 miles SW of the town of Thorn Junction, County of Humboldt, State of California. The project is located in Section 05, T05S, R02E, Humboldt Base and Meridian; in the Briceland U.S. Geological Survey 7.5-minute quadrangle; Humboldt County Assessor's Parcel Number 215-241-019; latitude 40.0548 N and longitude 123.9723 W at the point of diversion.

Project Description: The project is limited to two encroachments. One encroachment is for water diversion from and unnamed tributary to Bridge Creek. Water is diverted for domestic use and irrigation. Work for the water diversion will include use and maintenance of the water diversion infrastructure. The other proposed encroachment is to upgrade a failing culvert. Work for this encroachment will include excavation, removal of the failing culvert, replacement with new properly sized culvert, backfilling and compaction of fill, and rock armoring as necessary to minimize erosion.
